What is the Ron Cares Society?

Over the years, Ron Bergen has served his community by participating in a number of non-profit organisations. From this vantage point, he saw a few needs that were falling between the cracks.

In a conversation with a few close and trusted friends, he was encouraged to consider starting his own organisation to meet them.

He founded the Ron Cares Society back in the fall of 2022.

We're all familiar with people's basic needs -- things like food, clothing and shelter. These are so crucial and obvious that there are several solutions being coordinated for people in crisis. However, Ron noticed that needs one step away from the most basic were being missed. The needs of hygiene, including treatment of minor wounds, and preventative dental care. In stressful environments, neglected minor problems can become very serious, very quickly.

Ron Cares assembles Care Kits in 3 categories:

- Care Kits (especially for people experiencing houselessness)
- Senior/Elder Kits (for older people living on a fixed income)
- Family/Newcomer Kits (for people who are often putting their lives back together after a traumatic experience)

Where is Ron Cares Today?

Well, everywhere! If you've been to any event in the Langleys in the last couple of years, you've probably seen Ron there! Ron would like to express a special thank you to the growing team around Ron Cares, who have all put in countless hours and a boundless energy to join together in Caring.

So many people have contributed to Ron Cares, in so many ways, and the importance of that extends far beyond just our society.

It's not news to anyone that we're living in an overwhelming era when all the best -- and perhaps more importantly, the *worst* -- of everything is available at our fingertips. It is overwhelming, and living in perpetual overwhelm can cause serious harm to people, causing stress, apathy and cynicism.

The best antidote to feeling stuck or futile is to find people with shared values and priorities, and to organise. That's the key of what we're doing together. We're connected at the heart level, eager to Care for our community in the ways that available to us. In 2024, Ron Cares distributed 600 kits to the community.

Ron Cares is sustained by grants from organisations, gifts from businesses, and financial support from individuals like you!

What's Next?

There are two big projects that we're working on at Ron Cares.

We are seeking dual-purpose space to rent for product storage and kit-building. This is an increasingly pressing need as Ron Cares grows. Our location requirements are particular -- it needs to be close to Ron's house, and it needs to be accessible.

We're also working on obtaining registered charity status with CRA. This will allow us to offer tax receipts to our supporters, which is a way we can attract larger corporate and personal donations to make Ron Cares less dependent on grants.

As a disabled person with mobility challenges, Ron is very sensitive to the needs of people who need extra assistance. Ron Cares also has an advocacy mandate, working with like-minded organisations to meet needs, especially in transportation. **There is so much to do!**
